FOR VOLUNTEERS

Commitment:

NWMRC aims to provide support and training for all volunteers and in return we would like you to show some commitment as this uses much of our resources.

Meetings:

Attend meetings as appropriate.

Experience:

No formal experience or qualifications are necessary although good interpersonal and communication skills are needed.

Training:

All new volunteers receive training on aims & principles, equal opportunities and undertake an induction programme appropriate to their role.

Training is provided free of charge when authorized by the Centre Manager.

Travel Expenses:

Reasonable travel expenses are paid (on the submission of receipts) to volunteers for travel to the Centre, training, meetings etc.

Opportunities for paid work:

Volunteering with NWMRC does not guarantee a paid job. However, the experience is invaluable and many former volunteers are now in paid jobs either with NWMRC or other organisations.

Volunteer work with the Centre is widely regarded by employers as quality experience and many people use it as a stepping-stone to paid employment.
