



Choosing a Layout Style

UKI.NET sites are versatile and can be altered to achieve the look you want. Our site styles are not rigid templates. You can personalise the colour scheme, fonts, borders and more. Just about everything can be adjusted in the 'Website Design - Advanced Setup' area. Help sheets are available to show you how.

To get you started there are basic layout styles to choose from. Select the preset options by clicking the button next to the style you want and selecting the colour scheme from the drop down menu. Below is an overview of the basic layout options.

Vertical, left aligned menu. The page content is dynamic and the whole web site is centered.



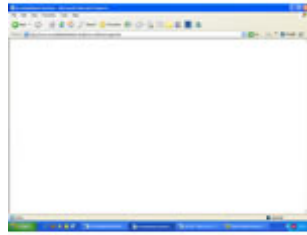
Horizontal, centre aligned menu. The page content is dynamic and the whole web site is centered.

No Menu Displayed. The page content fills the whole screen. This option is used when you want to embed pages into your existing web site so that you can update your own content. Ask for details.

What is fixed width, dynamic and full screen?

Most people will view your site using a screen resolution of 800 x 600 or 1024 x 768. A fixed width site viewed on a 1024 x 768 resolution will have some of the screen left empty but when viewed on a 800 x 600 screen the site will fill the entire area.

A style using a dynamic content layout will stretch the content so that it fills the available space.

The full screen option will fill the whole screen with your web site. Whatever screen resolution your visitors are using the content will stretch to fill the area.
